### 1. Jan Matejko and chess

*Route:* Juliusz Słowacki Theater, Matejko Square, National Museum, Market Square

Meeting at 9 a.m. Galaxy Hotel, by tram to the stop Dworzec Główny.

During the walking tour we visit places connected with great artist Jan Matejko - Academy of Fine Arts and Jan Matejko biographical museum created 120 years ago where we will see chess set he used to play with his friend, finding recreation in the game.

### 2. Excursion to the Wieliczka Salt Mine

*Route:* Wieliczka Salt Mine

Salt Mine at Wieliczka is the only one mine in the world working non-stop from the middle ages until now, from 1978 included to the UNESCO List of Cultural and Natural Heritage. You will experience magic of underground world decorated by miners with salt sculptures and places of worship. Must to see it!
