











European Pairs Blitz Chess Championship an accompanying event as part of the European Games Krakow-Malopolska 2023 Krakow/ Poland, 19th of June 2023

Regulations

1. ORGANIZERS

The Malopolska and Silesian Chess Association under the auspices of the European Chess Union and Polish Chess Federation

2. HOST CITY Krakow/ Poland

3. DATE 19th of June 2023 – European Pair Blitz Chess Championship an accompanying event as part of the European Games Krakow-Malopolska 2023

4. PARTICIPANTS

- 4.1 8 teams ECU members federations
 best combined Pair FIDE Classical rating 1st March 2023 list:
 Invited teams: 1. Ukraine 2. Azerbaijan 3. France 4. Poland 5. Romania
 6. Germany 7. Armenia 8. Netherlands
- 4.2 Each team consists of one player over 2650 (classical rating) at the open section, one female player over 2350 (classical rating) at the women section and one representative/captain*

*ECU may modify the rating criteria according to the teams/players availability

5. CONDITIONS/ACCOMMODATION

- 5.1 Each team will be provided with three (3) single rooms Full Board for two nights, 18 and 19 of June.
- 5.2 Transportation to hotel from and to Krakow airport.
- 5.3 There is not any entry fee.

6. SYSTEM OF PLAY

- 6.1 Rate of play is 3'+2" (3 minutes for a game for a player, with an increment of 2 seconds per move starting from the beginning).
- 6.2 Armageddon game: The player who wins the drawing of lots may choose the colour. The player with the white pieces receives 5 minutes; the player with the black pieces receives 4 minutes whereupon; after move 60, both players receive an increment of 2 seconds per move starting from move 61. In case of a draw the player with the black pieces is declared winner of the match.

Open section & Women Section

- a) Qualification: 8 players round robin tournament in each section:
- b) Play offs 1- 4 (1st round 1-4, 2-3) and 4-8 (1st round 4-8, 5-6) in each section. Play offs are played in double games with reversed colours. In case of tie (1-1) an Armageddon game follows.

Medals - Standings

- a) The individual medals are decided by the play offs in each section. Gold medal is for the winner of the final match and silver medal to the runner up. The bronze medal is for the winner of the match for the positions 3-4)
- b) The combined Pair medals are decided by the final position of the players of each team after the play offs in each section (sum of points):

 1st 8-points, 2nd 7⁻points, 3rd, 6-points, 4th 5-points, 5th 4-points, 6th 3-points, 7th 2-points 8th 1-point
- c) In case of tie between two teams the tiebreak criteria are the sum of points in open and women section in the qualification round.

7. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 7.1 The tournament is played according to the FIDE Laws of Chess, FIDE General Regulations for Competition and ECU Tournament Rules.
- 7.2 Default time The game is lost by the player who arrives at the chessboard after his flag has fallen.

8. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Chief arbiter and Appeals Committee will be announced by the European Chess Union.

9. PRIZES

- A. The 3 winners of Open, Women and Combine Pair section will receive gold, and silver and bronze medals same that will receive all participants of European Olympic Games.
- B. The best European Pair will receive the title of European Pair Chess Blitz Champion 2023.
